PUBLICATIONS

Instructions to authors

Abstracts should be up to 2 pages (including figures, tables, +/- references), A4 format, with margins of 25 mm top and bottom, 20 mm left and right. Abstracts should be prepared according to the following structure:

1. First line contains the **report title** (Times New Roman 14 pts, Bold, left alignment, without using capital letters, spacing after paragraph 8 pt).

2. The author's names (first name and surname, Times New Roman 11 pts, Bold/Italic, with superscript number after each author, left alignment, spacing after paragraph 8 pt).

3. The superscript number is followed by author's addresses including E-mail addresses (Times New Roman, 9 pts, left alignment, spacing after paragraph 8 pt).

4. Key words: up to 5 words (Times New Roman, 10 pts, left alignment, spacing after paragraph 12 pt).

5. The main body text should be written in MS Word, Normal style, font Times New Roman, 11 pts, 1.0 spacing, first line 0.5 cm, justified. **Subtitles** (if available): Times New Roman, 12 pts, bold, left alignment, spacing before paragraph 8 pt, after paragraph 3 pt.

6. References: Times New Roman, 10 pts, hanging 0.5 cm. Authors names: Surname, First name (initial), First name (initial), Surname, Year, Title, source, pages.

Tables (if available): Not wider than 16.5 (portrait) or 23.5 cm (landscape), in MSWord:

Figures (if available): Submitted separately from the text in *.tiff, *.cdr, *.jpg, *.eps or *.bmp format with resolution at least 600 dpi. The preferred location of tables and figures should be marked in the paper copy submitted by the authors.

Text to the figures and tables should be in separate file (Times New Roman, 10 pts).

The abstracts should be submitted on paper and in digital form to Nadezhda Veliniva, Geological Institute – BAS, e-mail: nvel@geology.bas.bg not later 17 h (Sofia time), October 1, 2009. Files of the texts, tables, figures, and texts to figures should have the name of the first author.
